A	Civic Pride & Community Endeavour	Community groups involved in instilling civic pride and encouraging community participation and endeavour.
B	Community Facility of the Year	Community facilities addressing the needs of the local community.
C	Sport & Recreation	Clubs & groups that have demonstrated a commitment to the community. Focusing in particular on the positive impact and response to community development needs.
D	Social Inclusion Award	Community groups that create opportunities for all to participate in local/community life.
E	Active Age Award	Active age groups providing support, activities and services by and for older people.
F	Gradam na Gaeilge	Community Groups promoting Irish language and culture.
G	Community/School Garden or Allotment	Community groups and/or schools who provide community/school gardens or who work on an allotment.
H	Community Sustainability Initiative	Community groups who are involved in and promote environmentally sustainable initiatives in their local community.

I	Corporate Endeavour	Community groups can nominate businesses supporting local community initiatives.
J	Volunteer of the Year	Community groups can nominate a volunteer who has made a significant contribution to their local community.

- Following receipt of submissions and entries, applicants will be shortlisted based on the information supplied, so it is vital that as much information as possible is provided.
- Community groups must be registered with the Public Participation Network (PPN).

Assessment

A panel of independent judges will assess entries and decide on awards based on community effort, participation, achievement, value to the community etc.

The judging panel reserve the right to re-categorise applications, if deemed appropriate.
